Celebrity photographer Rich Hardcastle returns to Mead Carney Fine Arts gallery for one week this January with a new photography exhibition carved out as a police drama. You might know Hardcastle for his cinematic photography, where every shot suggests a complex mystery lying just beyond the frame.

Rich Hardcastle & David Gandy

In this series, supermodel **David Gandy** takes on the role of leading man to play the detective in Hardcastle's stylised police drama. As the face of brands like **Marks & Spencer** and **Dolce & Gabbana**, we know best Gandy for *those* photographs of the British model in a pair of tight, white pants. Hardcastle's drama at **Mead Carney gallery**, **Dover Street**, however, gives this British male model an entirely new guise as the anonymous '**Mr Detective Man'**. Alongside there is a supporting cast includes actors like **Jacob Anderson**, **Game of Thrones' Grey Worm**, and **Paul Anderson** from **BBC's Peaky Blinders**. Hardcastle carefully choreographs each scene in his visual narrative in order to explore the darker elements of contemporary society.

The series follows on from the absurd and tragic, **Rich Hardcastle Dark Tales** exhibition earlier this year where the use of claustrophobic sets and ambiguous context created a powerful sense of uncertainty to unsettle the viewer.
